At a population of 42,645, the city is the core of one of the nation's smaller metropolitan areas. Burlington is a bustle of activity. # Montréal

An included trip will be a Milwaukee city tour including a visit to the Milwaukee Art Museum and the Pabst Mansion.

Downtown Madison is just 3 miles from Dane County International Airport. Accommodations, classes and meals will take place at Lowell Center Hotel on the University of Wisconsin Campus.
